(Kindergarten & 1st grade)

Daily activities for our youngest campers capture their enthusiasm and energy to create a day filled with arts & crafts, drama, dance, sports, and group times. Field trips for the Pioneers are geared toward their age and abilities, allowing them to experience camp at their level.



EXPLORERS

(2nd & 3rd Graders)

Building on all of the Pioneers activities, the Explorers now have a little more freedom in their schedules. Campers' Choice is offered two times a week and allows each camper to choose an additional activity to participate in. WEEKLY FIELD TRIPS



Most units take one field trip a week; Teen Scene campers go twice a week. Field trips are chosen based on age and ability. Pioneers go to water parks, beaches, and two extended day trips to Camp Henry Horner where boating, fishing, and s'mores complete the Total Camp Experience for our first-time campers.

Explorers, Trailblazers, and Teen Scene campers also take a variety of trips to local water parks, baseball games, zoos, and two over-nighters at Camp Henry Horner where they get to zip down the zip line or tackle the High Ropes Course followed by time at the lake, a cookout dinner, and a fun evening filled with camp activities before heading off to bed.
